Explore

Students will explore environmental justice issues and participate in hands-on activities that develop team-building and leadership skills through kayaking, biking, forest exploration, music, art and storytelling.



Engage

Students will learn from people, places and spaces that have helped shape current environmental justice policies and activism, and how to preserve and protect Mother Earth for current and future generations.



Empower

Students will assess and critique issues such as political power, racism, colonization and segregation, activism, and equitable access to resources, and explore their relationship with this land through diverse cultural lenses.
